

Printed Glass Splashbacks

SELECTING PHOTOGRAPHS

Sourcing a high resolution photograph from a professional photographer or image library will ensure colours and details are reproduced clearly, without issues of blurriness and pixelation.

There are many online image libraries to choose from and Google images is not one of them! These a few of the online image collections we recommend.

REPRODUCING COLOURS

The natural colour of the glass has a tinting effect, meaning printed images will never be 100% accurate to original colours. In darker images this colour difference is not noticeable, however lighter images may be prone to a slight colour shift.

Additionally, the colours below cannot be accurately reproduced on glass and we recommend avoiding them where possible.



IMAGE RESOLUTION

If you are purchasing an image from an online image library, select the highest available resolution and file size available.

IMAGE ORIENTATION

Ensure you select an image with a similar height and width ratio to that of your splashback size to ensure that its visual impact is not lost.



GLASS TYPE

We produce printed splashbacks on 6mm Toughened Low Iron Glass. This is a premium glass which is clearer than normal glass and allows for maximum vibrancy.

MAXIMUM PANEL SIZES

All of our printed splashbacks are produced on Grade A Safety Glass and can be printed up to a maximum size of 4300 x 2440mm.

IMAGINK SIGNOFF PROCESS

Prior to printing your glass, we will provide you a Digital Proof to confirm the scale and positioning of the printed image. Once we receive your approval to proceed, we will commence glass preparation and printing.
